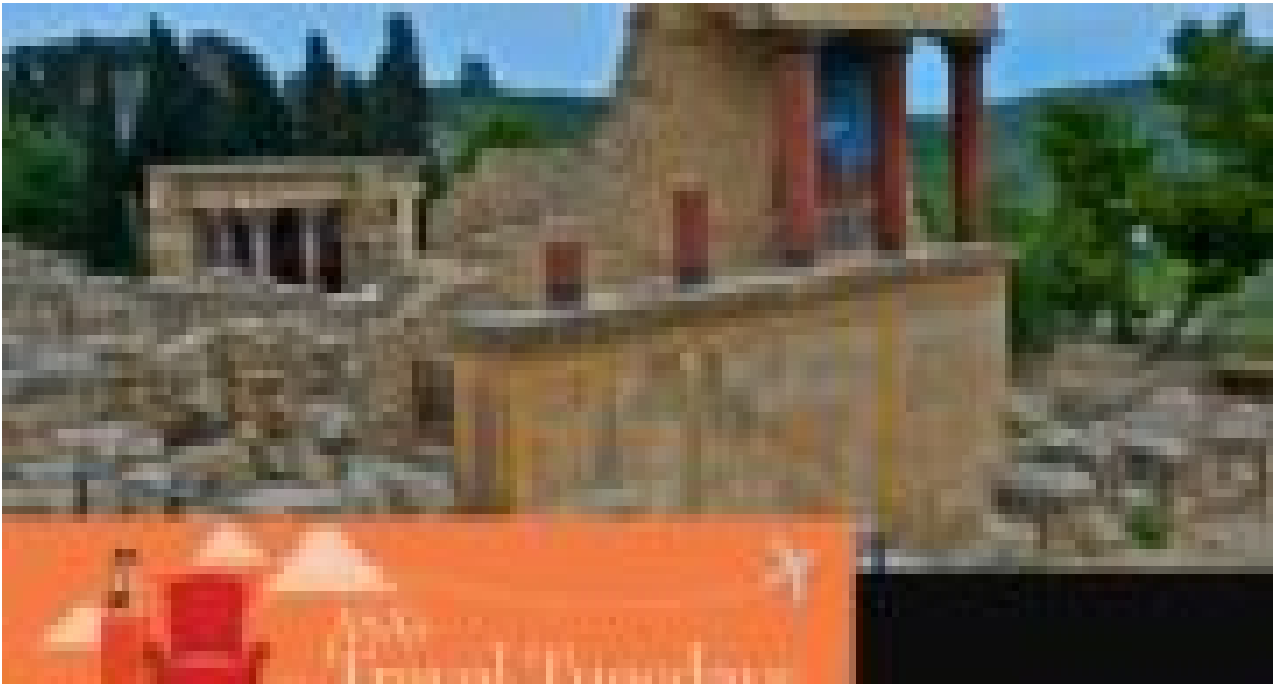


Travel Tuesdays: Explore the World Virtually – Episode 10

We visit towns and cities that Homer names, places that he may have visited, and others like Knossos and Mycenae and Pylos and Corinth, whose stories had been told in image and song for a thousand years.

In this talk, Dr Heather Sebo will visit some of those places and tell some of those stories. Along the way,

she will untangle what Homer has to say about the earliest Cretan myths—about Minos, Ariadne and the labyrinth, the craftsman Daedalus, ships that move by the power of thought and orchards that yield every kind of fruit, in and out of season, forever.
